

ORDINANCE NO. 006-186

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
EXECUTION OF A COLLECTIVE
BARGAINING AGREEMENT
CONTAINING THE TERMS OF THE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND
THE STATE AND MUNICIPAL
TEAMSTERS AND CHAUFFEURS
UNION, LOCAL 726, INTERNATIONAL
BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS,
CHAUFFEURS, WAREHOUSEMEN
AND HELPERS OF AMERICA

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transit Authority Act (70 ILCS 3605/28a) provides that the Chicago Transit Board has the right to deal with and enter into collective bargaining agreements with employees represented by a labor organization; and

WHEREAS, The State and Municipal Teamsters and Chauffeurs Union, Local 726, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen and Helpers of America ("Union") is the bargaining agent for approximately 120 Chicago Transit Authority employees; and

WHEREAS, On Tuesday, November 21, 2006, the Chicago Transit Authority and the Union reached a tentative agreement on the terms of a new, 3-year collective bargaining agreement (also known as the Wage and Working Conditions Agreement) effective January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2006; now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute a Wage and Working Conditions Agreement with the Union, incorporating the terms and conditions of the tentative agreement.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, and/or the President of the Chicago Transit Authority, or his designee, shall be authorized to apply such terms of the above-referenced Wage and Working Conditions Agreement as they deem appropriate to non-bargained for employees of the Chicago Transit Authority.
