WHEREAS, Following his discharge from the Authority, Robert Bono requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 88-81, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, A hearing was held on October 19, 2005; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board reviewed and considered the hearing committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The report of the hearing committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint of Robert Bono, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the February 15, 2006 Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. The Section 28 complaint filed by Robert Bono following his discharge on September 15, 2005 is hereby dismissed. Robert Bono's discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
