

ORDINANCE NO. 98-81

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC  
BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND  
AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR  
RENTAL OF TRAINING ROOMS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority's Management Development and Training Department provides training classes for CTA personnel; and

WHEREAS, The Management Development and Training Department requires conference/training rooms and equipment for such training classes; and

WHEREAS, The Holiday Inn Mart Plaza has previously provided conference/training rooms to the Authority for these services and is centrally located; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive public bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive public bidding for these services is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Holiday Inn Mart Plaza for rental of training rooms for twenty-four (24) months for thirty nine thousand six hundred sixty dollars (\$39,600.00), under requisition C980P 02002.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
