

ORDINANCE NO. 96-11

AN ORDINANCE DISMISSING THE
COMPLAINT OF RALPH BLACK

WHEREAS, Ralph Black requested a hearing pursuant to Section 328 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance No. 77-142, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a hearing committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, On July 14, 1995 and August 8, 1995, a hearing was held on the complaint filed by Ralph Black; and

WHEREAS, On December 19, 1995, Mr. Black submitted a request to have his complaint withdrawn; and

WHEREAS, On January 10, 1996 the Committee's recommendation that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice was presented to the Transit Board in executive session; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the request submitted by Ralph Black on December 19, 1995, the complaint filed by Ralph Black be and the same is hereby dismissed with prejudice.

SECTION 2. That the recommendation of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the complaint filed by Ralph Black, together with the transcript of the proceedings, shall be made a part of the minutes of the January 10, 1996 executive session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
