ORDINANCE NO. 96-5

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR RENTAL OF A PLATFORM SCISSORS LIFT

WHEREAS, In the course of performing priority rail structure repairs and to assist in the Green Line rehabilitation project the Authority utilized certain rental construction equipment including a platform scissors lift; and

WHEREAS, This equipment was in use by field personnel at 61st and Calumet from June, 1993 through and including November, 1994; and

WHEREAS, The original contract was insufficiently funded to pay all invoices due and owing for use of the rental equipment; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive public bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based upon the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive public bidding for this equipment is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Gilco Scaffolding Company for the use of one Simonlift platform scissors lift serial #50127 during the period of June, 1993 through and including November, 1994 at a not to exceed expenditure of eleven thousand four hundred fifty and 21/00 dollars (\$11,450.21) under requisition C950P 01056.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
