

ORDINANCE NO. 001-205

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
RATES OF FARE FOR CERTAIN TIMES
AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF
DONATIONS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Board desires to make public transportation readily accessible on New Year's eve and New Year's morning; and

WHEREAS, Section 3605/8 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act authorizes the Authority to accept gifts useful for its purposes; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chicago Transit Board hereby establishes one cent (\$0.01) as the fare for the use of the transit services and facilities of the Chicago Transit Authority effective 8:00 p.m. December 31, 2001, to 6:00 a.m. January 1, 2002.

SECTION 2. The Transit Board hereby determines that the fare established in Section 1 when combined with all other rates, fares and charges for transportation shall be sufficient in the aggregate to provide revenues to make those payments required by the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act.

SECTION 3. All Chicago Transit Authority ordinances, bylaws, rules and regulations not inconsistent with Section 1 of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. The President is authorized and directed to accept donations from any source to compensate the Authority for passengers utilizing the transit system between 8:00 p.m. on December 31, 2001 and 6:00 a.m. on January 1, 2002.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
