AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF CHICAGO FOR UPGRADES AT CERTAIN CTA FACILITIES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") and the City of Chicago, Department of Transportation ("CDOT") have undertaken the following projects to implement upgrades at the following subway facilities: (1) Clark/Division Mezzanine and Platform Renovation (Red Line);(2) Washington/Madison Mezzanine Platform and Tunnel Renovation (Red Line); and (3) Jackson Platform and Transfer Tunnel Renovation (Red/Blue Line); and

WHEREAS, The work to be performed includes the following: at Clark/Division Station (Red Line), installation of a new entrance/exit at LaSalle/Division requiring installation of new stairs, escalators, and elevators, with additional improvements to be made to the floors, walls, ceiling lighting, electrical communications, and signage; at the Washington/Madison Station (Red Line), upgrades to the transfer tunnel, mezzanine, and platform, including new lighting, electrical, communication systems, signage, and new finishes applied to the floor, walls, and ceiling; and at the Jackson Transfer Tunnel (Red/Blue Lines), new finishes on the floor, walls, and ceiling, with upgraded lighting, signage, electrical system, and drainage system; and

WHEREAS, The Authority will provide engineering and construction phase design services for this work; and

WHEREAS, The Authority desires to cooperate with the City on this construction project which will afford improved amenities for its passengers; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (Contract C01OP05107) with the City of Chicago by and through its Department of Transportation to implement upgrades at certain CTA facilities, which will include the following:

- a. provide engineering assistance and design criteria for the Clark/Division Red Line Station, including, but not limited to, projected train and bus schedules; the requirements for station fare collection, employee facilities and equipment, emergency and ADA features, janitorial, concession and storage facilities, requirements for structure, service communications, security system, electrical distribution and signal signage, and mechanical and structural design elements;
- b. attend interagency conferences concerning concepts, plans, specifications, and related matters, and shall prepare meeting minutes and reports as needed;
- c. review and comment upon concepts, plans, design, specifications, cost estimates and select shop drawings to be developed by the City, including the contract documents that will be presented to the CTA when they are approximately 30%, 60%, 90%, and 100% (for sign-of). CTA shall, with best efforts, respond in writing within fifteen (15) calendar days to each submittal;
- d. attend interagency conferences concerning Project progress, budget management, general agency coordination and interface;
- e. provide the City with the CTA's rail safety construction requirements for inclusion in the project specifications; and
- f. assist the City during construction of the Washington Transfer Tunnel, Jackson Transfer Tunnel, and Washington/Madison Red Line Station. CTA's assistance includes:
 - a) assist in the review of design modifications and the preparation of change orders, budget revisions, estimates of cost, scope revisions, and Project progress reports; and
 - b) provide field technicians, make inspections to determine if work complies with CTA standards, operational requirements, and attend construction review meetings.

SECTION 2. That the City of Chicago shall pass-through two hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$270,000) in FTA and IDOT funds to the Chicago Transit Authority for these services.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
