

ORDINANCE NO. 96-66

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH LOYOLA
UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO FOR
CONDUIT ATTACHMENT ON THE RED
LINE ELEVATED STRUCTURE

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") owns and maintains an elevated structure commonly referred to as the Red Line; and

WHEREAS, The Loyola University of Chicago, Lake Shore campus is located immediately adjacent to the Red Line and in close proximity to the Authority's Loyola Station; and

WHEREAS, Loyola University has requested permission to attach two conduits to the elevated structure in the vicinity of the Loyola station, as identified on the proposed cable/conduit route attached hereto as Exhibit A, to enhance its telecommunications network; and

WHEREAS, Staff has negotiated an annual license fee in the amount of one thousand one hundred twenty five dollars (\$1,125.00) for the conduit attachments; now, therefore:


BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Chicago Transit Authority, as Licensor, a License Agreement with Loyola University of Chicago, as Licensee, for the attachment of two telecommunications network conduits to the Red Line elevated structure in the vicinity of the Loyola Station.

SECTION 2. The annual fee for the license agreement shall be one thousand one hundred twenty five dollars (\$1,125.00).

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
