

ORDINANCE NO. 98-61

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE
SALARY OF DON JACKSON AS
A MEMBER OF THE CHICAGO
TRANSIT BOARD

WHEREAS, Don Jackson has been appointed a member of the Chicago Transit Board by Mayor Richard M. Daley to complete the unexpired term of Arthur F. Hill, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson has taken and subscribed the constitutional oath of office and has filed it in the office of the Illinois Secretary of State and all other requirements of Section 20 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act, 70 ILCS 3605/20 have been met; now,


BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The appointment of Don Jackson, as a member of the Chicago Transit Board to a term ending September 1, 2000, is hereby made a matter of record upon the permanent files of this Board.

SECTION 2. The salary of Don Jackson as a member of the Chicago Transit Board is hereby fixed at a rate of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) per annum. He shall also be entitled to any current and future benefits available under existing and future insurance and retirement plans available to employees, officers or Board members of the Authority.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
