

ORDINANCE NO. 016-5

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN  
APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN  
THE CITY OF CHICAGO'S DRIVE  
CLEAN CHICAGO CLEAN TRUCK  
VOUCHER FUND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Authority is committed to improving air quality and participating in programs that reduce carbon emissions; and

WHEREAS, The City of Chicago offers financial incentives through its Drive Clean Chicago Clean Truck Voucher Fund Program ("Drive Clean Program") to encourage entities to use electric and hybrid (E&HV) technology in medium and heavy-duty vehicle classes in the Chicago metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, The Authority previously entered into an agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc. ("Enterprise") for the Authority to lease vehicles for its non-revenue fleet; and

WHEREAS, The existing contract between the Authority and Enterprise permits the implementation of the E&HV technology into the vehicles that the Authority leases from Enterprise, and the Authority and Enterprise have agreed to participate in the Drive Clean Program; and

WHEREAS, Both the Authority and Enterprise will sign the application to participate in the Drive Clean Program, with Enterprise signing as the vehicle purchaser and the Authority signing as the vehicle lessee; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise will purchase the E&HV technology at an after-rebate cost of approximately Two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200.00) per vehicle; and

WHEREAS, The Authority will pay Enterprise increased leasing costs for each vehicle into which the E&HV technology is installed, which the Authority expects to recoup through fuel cost savings; and

WHEREAS, The E&HV technology will reduce carbon emissions by approximately Twenty Percent (20%); and

WHEREAS, The City of Chicago requires each participant in the Drive Clean Program to indemnify the City from any claims related to participation in the Drive Clean Program; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

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SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Transit Board of the Chicago Transit Authority, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit an application with Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc. to participate in the City of Chicago's Drive Clean Chicago Clean Truck Voucher Fund Program.

SECTION 2. The application terms and conditions require the Authority to indemnify the City of Chicago, require Enterprise to co-sign the application, and contain such other terms and conditions as are substantially in conformance with Exhibit A hereto.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
