ORDINANCE NO. 005-104

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE CONTAINED IN THE RENTAL AGREEMENT WITH ENTERPRISE LEASING CO. OF CHICAGO

WHEREAS, Staff sought bids, under Requisition B05OP01807, for the rental of two mid-size automobiles for a period of eleven months; and

WHEREAS, These automobiles will be utilized by the Office of the Inspector General; and

WHEREAS, Under the bid process, Enterprise Leasing Co. of Chicago was the only responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, Under the normal purchasing process, Enterprise Leasing Co. of Chicago's bid price of \$16,000.00 is an amount that would not require Board approval; and

WHEREAS, The vendor's rental agreement requires the Authority to indemnify it for personal injury or damage to the automobiles caused by the use or operation of the automobiles during the rental period; and

WHEREAS, Due to the indemnification clause contained in the rental agreement, staff now seeks Board approval for entry into the subject rental agreement; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Vice President of Purchasing and Warehousing is authorized to execute an agreement with Enterprise Leasing Co. of Chicago for the rental of two mid-size automobiles in an amount not to exceed \$16,000.00, for eleven months, under Requisition No. B05OP01807. The Authority is authorized to indemnify Enterprise Leasing Co. of Chicago as set forth in the rental agreement.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
