ORDINANCE NO. 003-95

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PUBLIC BIDDING DISADVANTAGEOUS AND AUTHORIZING THE SERVICES FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF SECURITY SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority is in need of services for maintenance and repair of security systems at 901 West Division St. (Central Warehouse), 120 North Racine Ave. (Engineering/Control Center), 3900 West Maypole Avenue (West Shops), 31st Street and Federal (Training Center), 3701 Oakton (Skokie Shops/Rail Heavy Maintenance), and Merchandise Mart, for a period of twenty-four (24) months; and

WHEREAS, Video and Sound Service, Inc., was the original contractor for the installation of the CCTV and access control security system; and

WHEREAS, Using one firm for the installation and maintenance of the security systems is recommended to reduce exposure and risk to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Section 54.3-5 of the Regulations Governing Purchase and Sales Transactions provides for the award of contracts in those situations where the Transit Board determines that competitive bidding would be disadvantageous; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Transit Board hereby determines that competitive bidding for this service is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Video and Sound Service, Inc., to provide maintenance and repair of security systems at 901 West Division St. (Central Warehouse), 120 North Racine Ave. (Engineering/Control Center), 3900 West Maypole Avenue (West Shops), 31st Street and Federal (Training Center), 3701 Oakton (Skokie Shops/Rail Heavy Maintenance), and Merchandise Mart for a period of twenty-four (24) months in the amount of one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000.00) under Requisition B03OP00942.
