

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

DAILY ALLEY CLOSURES

Dates: Monday, March 25 to Wednesday, April 24, 2024

Location: The alley east of:
5843 – 5921 N. Broadway

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm, weekdays and Saturdays
(Prep work will begin at least ½ hour prior to start of shift)

Work Activity: Embankment Wall Repairs

Local Impact:

- Crews will block access to the alley and garages/parking spaces *directly adjacent to the embankment wall* during stated work hours.
- Access to the alley and garages/parking spaces will be available at the end of each work day.
- **There will be no through traffic at all times in the alley behind 5921 N. Broadway from 7pm-Thursday, April 11 until 7pm-Friday, April 12 (7pm-Thursday, April 18 to 7pm-Friday, April 19 as backup dates).**
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.

- Access to parking spaces in the alley for 1128 W. Ardmore Avenue and 5821 N. Broadway will be coordinated and maintained from one end of the alley or the other with intermittent delays during segment delivery on W. Ardmore Avenue.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from retaining wall chipping and surface preparation
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
 - **Loud overnight noise from retaining wall chipping and surface preparation from 9pm-Thursday, April 11 to 7am-Friday, April 12 (9pm-Thursday, April 18 to 7am-Friday, April 19 as backup dates)**
