

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

## 48-Hour Notice

**Dates:** Monday, July 7 through Thursday, July 31, 2025

**Locations:** 348 W. 108<sup>th</sup> Place

**Work Hours:** 8am to 4pm, daily

**Work Activity:** Building Demolition & Chicago Fire Department Training

**Local Impact:**

- Partial sidewalk and street closures may occur in the work zone while work is being performed.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed.
  - Noise may include:
    - General demolition noise
    - Running of air compressors, excavators, and generators
    - Use of pneumatic and gas impact tools
    - Truck traffic
    - Beeping from back-up alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
- Rodent abatement will be performed throughout the work activity.
- There will be dust while the work is being performed, and the contractor will implement the necessary procedures to mitigate the dust.
- CFD training may occur on the site prior to demolition.
