

ORDINANCE NO. 014-12

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING
COMPETITIVE BIDDING
DISADVANTAGEOUS AND
AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A
CONTRACT TO PROVIDE AUTODESK
SUBSCRIPTION PROGRAM
ENROLLMENT TO DLT SOLUTIONS,
INC.

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority's ("Authority") Engineering and Facilities Maintenance Departments use Autodesk, Inc.'s AutoCAD software; and

WHEREAS, The AutoCAD software is used for the preparation and storage of drawings specifications used in the repair, maintenance, and construction of Authority facilities; and

WHEREAS, The latest updates of the AutoCAD software are needed to maintain compatibility between Authority's Engineering and Facilities Management Departments and outside contractors; and

WHEREAS, DLT Solutions, Inc. is the only vendor to hold a General Services Administration (GSA) contract for Autodesk, Inc.'s AutoCAD products; and

WHEREAS, In addition to the software, DLT Solutions, Inc. will provide improvements, updates and modular extensions of the AutoCAD software and e-Learning training courses; and

WHEREAS, It would be advantageous to the Authority to utilize GSA Schedule pricing to benefit from "most-favored customer" pricing GSA Schedules offers; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.4D of the Procurement Policies and Procedures provides for the award of contracts without competitive bidding where federal funds are not utilized and the Chicago Transit Board "determines that competitive Bidding is disadvantageous"; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That based on the statements set forth in the preamble of this ordinance, the Chicago Transit Board hereby determines that competitive bidding for this software and related services is disadvantageous.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the Autodesk Subscription program enrollment with DLT Solutions, Inc., for a period of up to twelve (12) months, in the not-to-exceed amount of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), under contract No. B14OP01907.

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SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
