Description: Professional consulting services and the ability to purchase Cisco brand hardware, software, and SMARTnet maintenance services for up to three years

Change Order No. 1 provides for an increase to the contract to fully update CTA's network infrastructure as follows:

- 11 rail yards \$1,650,000.00
- 7 bus garages \$1,050,000.00
- 901 W. Division (Central Warehouse) and Beverly non-revenue garage \$300,000.00
- Disaster Recovery Site \$1,000,000.00
- Completion of 567 W. Lake upgrades \$1,000,000.00
- Control Center \$1,000,000.00

Total Change Order No. 1: \$6,000,000.00 Revised Contract Amount: \$13,867,726.94
