















#### SERVICE REDUCTIONS

Hours and days of service remain unchanged, but service will operate less frequently.











#### ANNUAL 2009 RIDERSHIP

- Down for the year, yet better than projected



#### CTA RIDERSHIP OVER THE DECADE

- Ridership has grown 11.7% since 1999
- Bus is up 6.6% and Rail has increased 21.7%
- **■** Weekend ridership has grown by 28%



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
