7	CHAIRMAN BARCLAY: Our next order of
8	business is the review of an ordinance authorizing
9	implementation of bus route number X4 Cottage Grove
10	Express. Mike Connelly?
11	MR. CONNELLY: Yes. Good morning. I'm
12	Mike Connelly your Chief Planning Officer. Staff are
13	recommending implementation of an overlay express bus
14	route on the number 4 Cottage Grove bus corridor.
15	Number 4 Cottage Grove route is a solid, heavily used
16	bus route which connects to the south side, and into
17	downtown, as well as providing well-used local service
18	along this vital corridor.
19	This route sees many very long bus
20	trips, which would benefit greatly from express bus
21	service. There are also many riders who utilize this
22	bus for short connecting trips, with many on's and
23	off's throughout the length of the Cottage Grove
24	corridor.

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This combination of patterns suggests an overlay express route while retaining full local service, which is exactly what staff are recommending. Almost half of the current riders board at the potential express stops. This route has very strong non-peak direction ridership, which calls for implementation of bidirectional express service. to the next slide.

> The express route is proposed to t.h

operate between 95 Street on the south, through the turnback on East Water Street, downtown, just south of the intersection of Wacker Drive and Michigan Avenue. The express route will operate with half mile stop spacing south of downtown. The usual bus route stop spacing ranging from one-eighth to one-quarter of a mile.

This will help to speed trips, and reduce the travel time for express bus riders by between nine and 17 minutes, depending on the length of their trip. We can expect that this service enhancement will lead to increased ridership, and will fit in well with the current return to transit trends that we've been seeing.

The operation of an express route

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compliments the Better Streets for Buses Initiative, which we are working on with CTA. As with other elements of the Better Streets for Buses Plan, such as transit signal priority, or exclusive bus lanes, express route implementation is intended to improve bus operation, providing improved service for our customers on the bus system.

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The Cottage Grove corridor is also a part of the Bronzeville Invest Southwest Corridor, and helps to enhance the other investments which the City of Chicago is putting into place. For CTA, the Cottage Grove route is both a low-income route, and a minority route.

This reflects CTA's commitment to supporting equity in public transit service provision, and the investment of 1.9 million of annual operating funding towards its enhancement of bus service on the south side. This map outlines both the local, and the express bus routes on Cottage Grove Avenue.

The local is out in teal, and the express route is shown as a purple line on this map.

The red dots that you can see are the express route stops, which as I've mentioned, are at one-half mile stop spacing south of Roosevelt. Staff are excited to

bring this south side route improvement proposal to you. I'll be glad to answer any questions which you may have. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN BARCLAY: Well first I'd like to commend you on what this new route, the express route. We're glad to see this in an area that is well deserving of this, the volume is very high. I know on the number 4 bus, so thank you very much for that. Did you get any feedback from the community?

MR. CONNELLY: We've heard from people throughout the service area at public meetings that we've had, on both the Invest Southwest meetings with the City and others that we've held, that people are looking for improvements to bus service. something that people mentioned not only to us directly, but also in the survey work that we've been

CHAIRMAN BARCLAY: Any other comments from any other Board member?

MS. ORTIZ: No. I second your comments in terms of this being a really important route, and I appreciate also the fact that it will be saving times for other riders who are actually commuting for very long distances into downtown, thank you.
