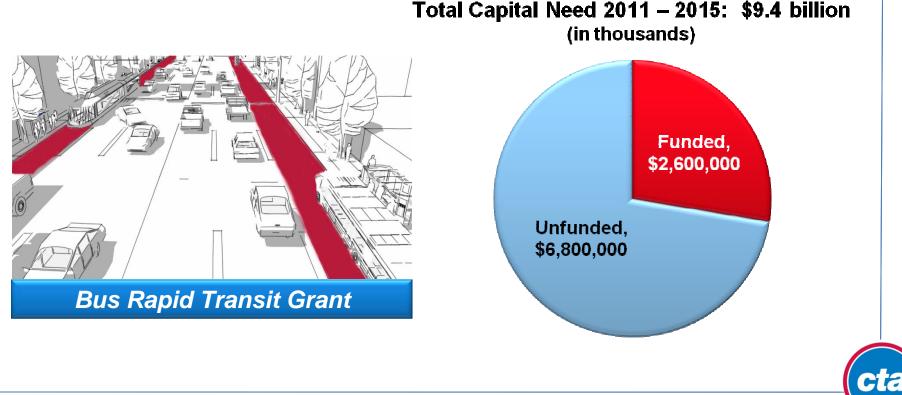

- Outlined state of good repair projects







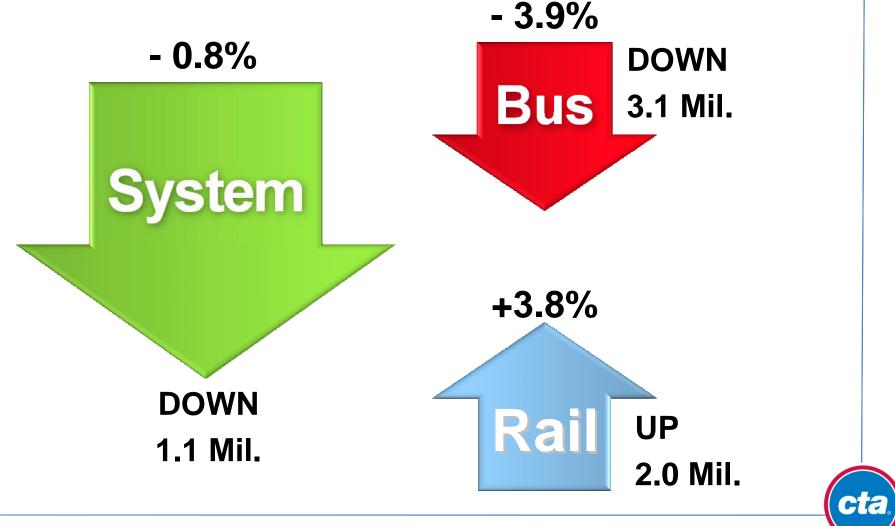

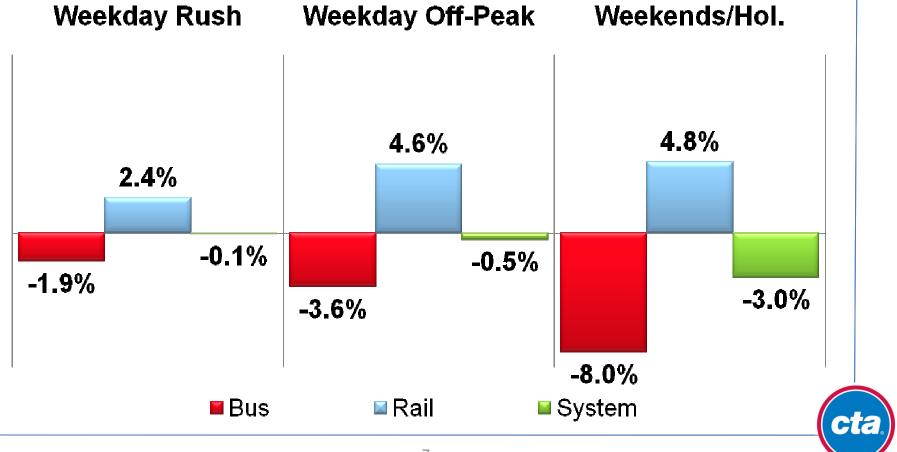
3RD QUARTER 2010 RIDERSHIP

• 133.7 million rides provided from July thru September



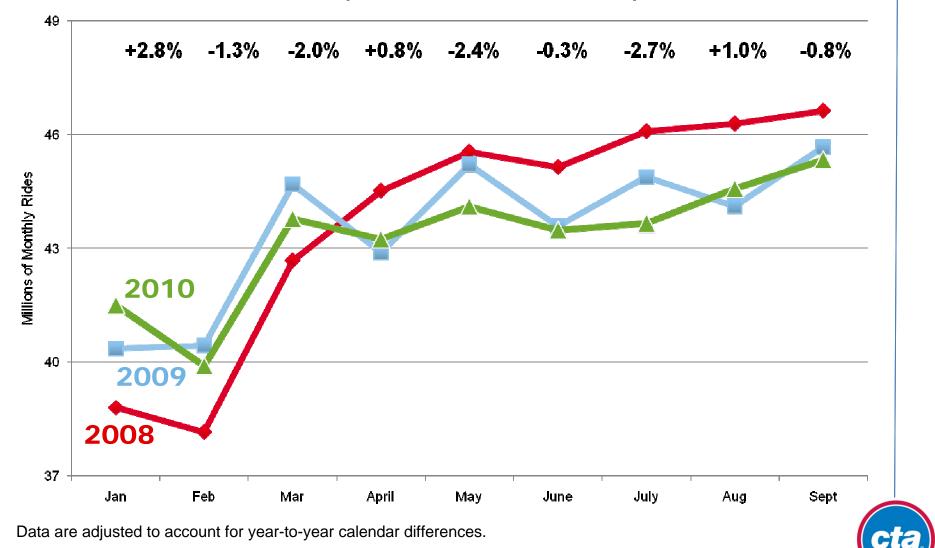
3RD QUARTER, CHANGE BY TIME PERIOD • Ridership fairly stable during rush

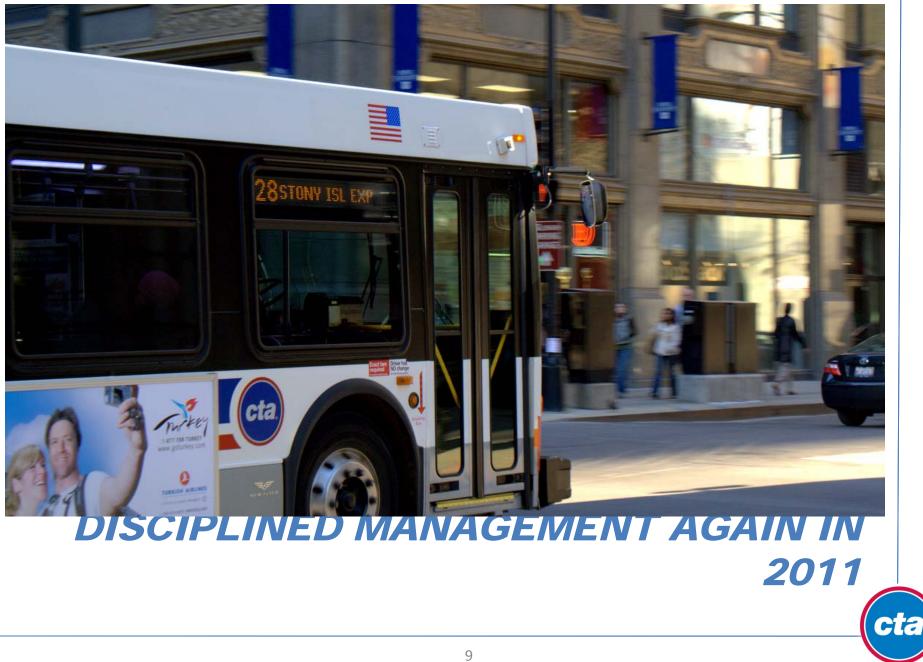
 Off-peak, particularly weekends, has suffered from economy and service cuts

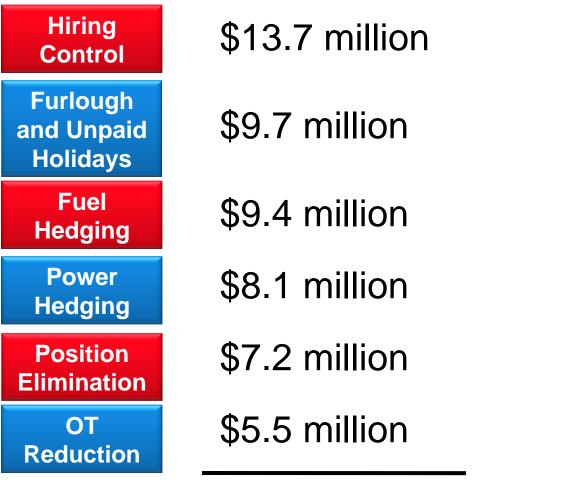

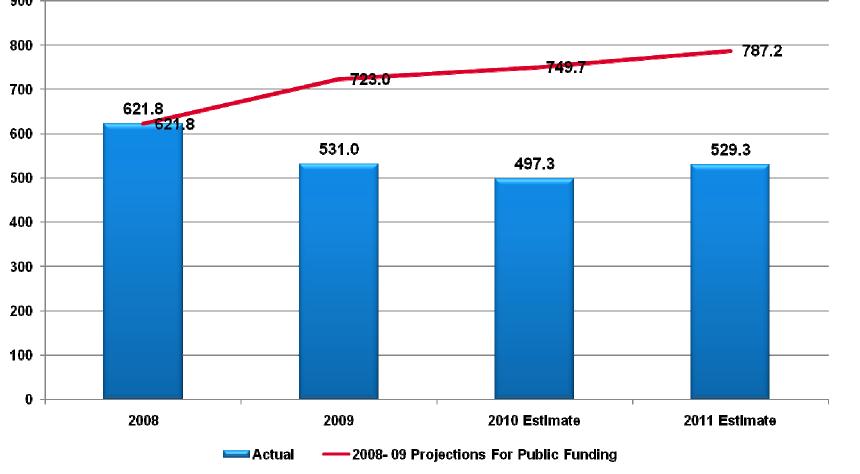

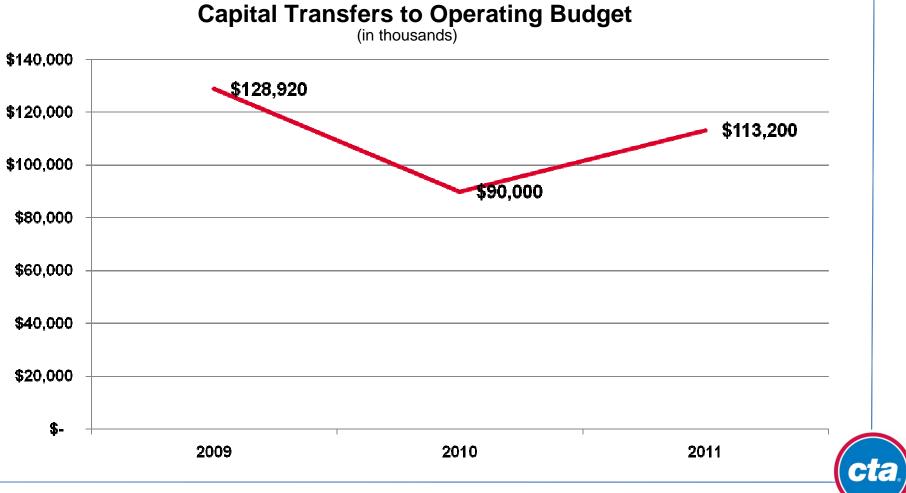
UNDERPERFORMING PUBLIC FUNDING
