We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Location: CTA's Elevated Structure west of 3636-3740 N. Wilton Avenue
Public alley east of 3637-3763 N. Sheffield Avenue

Work Hours: Weekdays 7am to 5pm

Saturdays 6am to 6pm

Work Activity: Cable Zip Tying

Local Impact:

- Access to Garages/Parking Space located on private property and not under the CTA ROW/Structure for residents at 3637-3763 N Sheffield Avenue will be maintained with intermittent delays as crews move.
- Access to the public alley east of 3637-3763 N. Sheffield Avenue will remain accessible with flagger assistance.
- Vehicles and canvas tents must be removed from underneath the CTA tracks at 3620–3756 N. Wilton Ave. during this work. The contractor will work around existing parking canopies but is not responsible for protecting any vehicles or personal property left under the structure, and alternate parking will not be provided.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including overnight noise.
Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horn
