

# Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

## Daily Alley Closures

**Dates:** Tuesday, July 7 – Monday, July 13, 2026  
**Location:** W Ardmore Avenue to W Thorndale Avenue, east side of the tracks  
**Work Hours:** 7am to 4pm (Weekdays)  
**Work Activity:** Fence Installation

- The posted dates represent the anticipated work window for these activities. Construction operations may occur intermittently throughout this period and may not take place each day.
- Drivers will not be able to travel through the alley while work is taking place, however residential parking areas will remain accessible throughout construction.
- Properties located at 5800–5930 N Broadway Avenue, 1128 W Ardmore, and 115-1130 W Thorndale Avenue may experience intermittent delays entering and exiting parking areas via the alley during work hours (8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.). Traffic flaggers will assist residents with vehicle access while work is occurring.
- On garbage collection days, refuse and recycling bins will be moved to the end of the alley for collection and returned following pickup.
- Residents may experience construction-related noise during work activities, including:
  - General construction noise
  - Backup alarms from construction vehicles and equipment
