

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Daily Alley Closures

Dates: Monday, September 14 to Monday, October 12, 2026

Location: Alley east of 5619 – 5657 N Broadway, 1118 – 1144 W Bryn Mawr
(W Bryn Mawr to W Hollywood Avenue) West Side of the tracks

Work Hours: 7am to 4pm (Weekdays)
7am to 6pm (Saturdays)

Work Activity: Alley Resurfacing, Fence, and Curb Installation

Local Impact:

- The posted dates represent the anticipated work window for these activities. Construction operations may occur intermittently throughout this period and may not take place each day.
- No through traffic will be permitted in the alley during work activities; however, access from Broadway will remain open and unobstructed.
- Properties located at 1118-1144 W Bryn Mawr Avenue and 5605-5657 N Broadway may experience intermittent delays entering and exiting parking areas via the alley during work hours (7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.). Traffic flaggers will assist residents with vehicle access while work is occurring.
- **Additional 24 HR Notice will be given for upcoming Alley Resurfacing dates where no vehicles will be able to park/leave their parking during work hours (8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.).**
- On garbage collection days, refuse and recycling bins will be moved to the end of the alley for collection and returned following pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
