

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Friday, May 22 to Tuesday, May 26, 2020

Location: Red and Purple Lines – CTA southbound tracks from Thorndale Station to Lawrence Station

Work Hours: 10pm-Friday to 4am-Tuesday (Continuous around the clock work)

Work Activity: Contact Rail Replacement

Local Impact:

- A crane will be staged in the parking lot at 1130 W. Lawrence.
- There will be noise while work is being performed.
Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Use of pneumatic tools
 - Metal on metal material handling
 - Noise from rail equipment, crane and maintenance equipment
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
- This is rolling construction work, no singular location outside of the area where the crane is staged will have constant noise while the work activity is taking place.
