

# Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

**Dates:** Monday, September 27 to Friday, October 1, 2021

**Location:** W. Ainslie Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

**Work Hours:** 7am-7pm weekdays  
Continuous, 24/7 street closure

**Work Activity:** Viaduct Demolition

**Local Impact:**

- W. Ainslie Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic.
- **Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages on the north side of W. Ainslie Street (1100–1112 W. Ainslie St).**
- The exit to the parking garage on the south side of W. Ainslie Street will be maintained.
- Sidewalks within the work zone on both sides of the street will be closed.
- The contractor will maintain access to residences.
- Alley access via W. Lawrence Avenue to the south and W. Argyle Street to the north will be maintained.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.
- If you need further information about alternative parking please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
  - General construction noise
  - Loud noise from viaduct demolition
  - Running air compressors, excavators, and generators
  - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
  - Beeping for backup alarms on vehicles
  - Flagging horns
