

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Tuesday, January 19 to Wednesday, March 24, 2021

Location: The alley behind 5800-5828 N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 4pm, weekdays; potential Saturday work

Work Activity: ComEd Overhead and Underground Utility Work

Local Impact:

- The alley will be closed within the work zone during stated work hours.
- Vehicles may be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces during stated work hours.
- The contractor will provide alternate parking for impacted residents on a first-come, first-served basis at the Bryn Mawr lot located just southeast of the Bryn Mawr Red Line station (1111-1115 W. Bryn Mawr Avenue).
- If you need further information about alternative parking and temporary parking passes, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- Beginning January 25th, residents who are not impacted by the work will be able to enter and exit the alley via Thorndale Avenue.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from excavation and pouring
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horn
