SIDEWALK & EXTENDED ALLEY CLOSURES

- Dates:** Weekdays & Saturdays
Thursday, June 16 to Saturday, July 2, 2022
- Location:** - W. Argyle Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue
- The alley behind 4900 - 4954 N. Winthrop Avenue
(W. Ainslie Street to W. Argyle Street)
- Work Hours:** 7am-7pm, **continuous 24/7 sidewalk & alley closure**
- Work Activity:** Drilled Shaft Installation
- Local Impact:** W. Argyle Street

- The sidewalk within the work zone on the south side of W. Argyle Street will be closed.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Argyle Street will be open.

4900-4954 N. Winthrop Avenue

- Crews will work north to south.
- The alley will be closed at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between W. Argyle Street and W. Ainslie Street during this closure.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.

- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horns
