

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Weekdays & Saturdays

Dates: Thursday, March 17 to Saturday, April 30, 2022

Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments.

Location: - W. Berwyn Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

- The alley behind 5200 - 5268 N. Winthrop Avenue

(W. Foster Avenue to W. Berwyn Avenue)

Work Hours: 7am-7pm, continuous 24/7 sidewalk & alley closure

Work Activity: Drilled Shaft Installation

Local Impact:

- Crews will work north to south beginning with the work on W. Berwyn Avenue.
- Once the drilled shaft work is completed at W. Berwyn Avenue, the crew will mobilize into the alley.

W. Berwyn Avenue (Approximately 3-4 days)

- The parking lane within the work zone on the south side of W. Berwyn Avenue will be closed.
- There will be traffic lane shifts with flagger assistance on W. Berwyn Avenue.
- The sidewalk within the work zone on the south side of W. Berwyn Avenue will be closed.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Berwyn Avenue will be open.

5200-5268 W. Winthrop Avenue

- The alley will be closed at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between W. Foster Avenue and W. Berwyn Avenue during this closure.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.

- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - o General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
