Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

## UPDATED DATES SIDEWALK & ALLEY IMPACTS

**Dates:** Saturday, June 24 to Tuesday, July 11, 2023

**Location:**

- 1113-1121 W. Bryn Mawr Avenue
- The alley behind 5500-5558 N. Winthrop Avenue (W. Catalpa Avenue to W. Bryn Mawr Avenue)
- W. Catalpa Avenue from the CTA Tracks east to the alley

**Work Hours:** 7am-7pm, weekdays & Saturdays  
(Prep work will begin at least ½ hour prior to start of shift)

**Work Activity:** Bryn Mawr Stage B Temporary Station Construction

**Local Impact:** 1113-1121 W. Bryn Mawr Avenue

- There will be intermittent sidewalk closures with flagger assistance on the south side of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will remain open at all times.
- Access to the Bryn Mawr station entrance on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained at all times.

5500-5558 N. Winthrop Avenue

- Crews will intermittently block access to the alley and garages/parking spaces during stated work hours.
- Access to garages/parking spaces will be maintained from one end of the alley at all times.
- Access to the parking lot at 5518 N. Winthrop Avenue will be maintained from one end of the alley at all times.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.

W. Catalpa Avenue

- There will be intermittent sidewalk closures on the north side of W. Catalpa Avenue.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Catalpa Avenue will remain open at all times.

Noise Impacts

- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging Horns
