- The parking lane on the south side of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be closed until the work activity is completed.
 - There will be traffic lane shifts with flagger assistance on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue.
 - There will be intermittent sidewalk closures with flagger assistance on the south side of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue during stated work hours.
 - The sidewalk on the north side of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will remain open at all times.
 - Access to the Bryn Mawr station entrance on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained at all times.
 - There will be noise while work is being performed, **including nighttime noise:**
Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Noise from crane lifting and setting equipment
 - Flagger horns
