

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

TRAFFIC LANE SHIFTS & SIDEWALK IMPACTS

Dates: Monday, September 18 to Friday, September 22, 2023

Location: W. Bryn Mawr Avenue between N. Broadway and N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm
(Prep work will begin at least ½ hour prior to start of shift)

Work Activity: Viaduct Demolition

Local Impact:

- There will be traffic lane shifts with flagger assistance on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue within the work zone during stated work hours.
- The parking lane on both sides of the street within the work zone will be closed.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue.
- One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary. *(The contractor will close the sidewalk if it is deemed unsafe).*
- Residents north of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue on the **east** side of the CTA Tracks will need to access the alley via W. Hollywood Avenue.
- Access to businesses on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained.
- Access to the Bryn Mawr station entrance on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, **including nighttime noise:**
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from viaduct demolition
 - Running air compressors, excavators and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction vehicles and equipment
