We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments

Location: W. Catalpa Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: **7am to 5pm, weekdays & Saturdays**

(Prep work to begin at least ½ hour prior to start of shift)

Work Activity: Material Deliveries & Noise Barrier Installation

Local Impact:

- There will be traffic lane shifts with flagger assistance on W. Catalpa Avenue.
- The parking lane on both sides of the street will be closed.
- Sidewalk closures will alternate between the north and south sides of the street with flagger assistance when necessary.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- Access to the alley south of W. Catalpa Avenue will be maintained from W. Balmoral Avenue.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from crane lifting and setting equipment
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
