SIDEWALK IMPACTS & EXTENDED ALLEY CLOSURE

Dates: Monday, July 25 to Wednesday, August 27, 2022

Location:

W. Winona Street from the CTA Tracks east to the alley

The alley behind William C. Goudy School (W. Winona Street to W. Foster Avenue)

W. Foster Avenue from the CTA Tracks east to the alley

Work Hours: 7am-7pm, weekdays & Saturdays

(Prep work will begin at least 1/2 hour prior to start of shift)

Local Impact:

W. Winona Street: In conjunction with the work in the south half of the alley

- There will be intermittent sidewalk closures on the north side of W. Winona Street.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Winona Street will remain open at all times.

The alley behind William C. Goudy School

- Alley closures will alternate between the south half and north half of the alley.
- The contractor will first complete the foundation installation work on the south half of the alley and then proceed to the north half of the alley.
- Access to the alley will alternate between W. Foster Avenue and W. Winthrop Avenue.
- The contractor will maintain access for handicap parking and deliveries.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.

W. Foster Avenue: In conjunction with the work in the north half of the alley

- There will be intermittent sidewalk closures on the south side of W. Foster Avenue.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Foster Avenue will remain open at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from excavation and pouring
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
