Work Activity: Interlocking Decommissioning

Local Impact:

- The alleys may be intermittently blocked by construction equipment and vehicles; local access will be maintained.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Metal on metal material handling
 - Noise from rail equipment
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horns
