We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Location:

W. Montrose Avenue between N. Clifton Avenue and N. Kenmore Avenue

The alley west of 4134-4364 N. Kenmore Avenue

Work Hours:

7am Fridays to 10pm Tuesdays - Continuous daytime and nighttime work

7am-7pm, Wednesdays and Thursdays

Work Activity: Track Renewal

Local Impact:

- W. Montrose Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic during this work activity.
- The sidewalks on W. Montrose Avenue will be closed on one side at a time.
- The alley behind 4134-4364 N. Kenmore Avenue will be intermittently blocked by construction equipment and vehicles.
- Vehicle access to enter/exit garages and parking spaces will be maintained.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- Delivery and local traffic access to N. Sunnyside Avenue will be maintained.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Metal on metal material handling
 - Noise from rail equipment, crane and maintenance equipment
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
