

# Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

**Dates:** Monday, June 7 to Friday, June 18, 2021

**Location:** W. Ainslie Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

**Work Hours:** 7am to 7pm, weekdays and Saturday; **continuous 24/7 street closure**

**Work Activity:** Track and System Demolition

**Local Impact:**

- W. Ainslie Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic.
- **Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages on the north side of W. Ainslie Street (1100–1112 W. Ainslie St).**
- The exit to the parking garage on the south side of W. Ainslie Street will be maintained.
- When possible, one sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance if necessary.
- The contractor will maintain access to residences.
- Alley access via W. Lawrence Avenue to the south and W. Argyle Street to the north will be maintained.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.
- If you need further information about alternative parking and temporary parking passes, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
  - General construction noise
  - Track Demolition Noise
  - Noise from rail equipment, crane, and maintenance equipment
  - Beeping for backup alarms on vehicles
  - Flagging horns
