

# Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

**Dates:** Monday, August 9 to Wednesday, August 25, 2021

**Location:** W. Catalpa Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

**Work Hours:** 7am-7pm weekdays and Saturdays (Continuous, 24/7 street closure)

**Work Activity:** Viaduct and Abutment Demolition

**Local Impact:**

- W. Catalpa Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- One sidewalk within the work zone will remain open at all times, unless it is unsafe to do so.
- Residents south of W. Catalpa Avenue will need to access the alley via W. Balmoral Avenue.
- Residents north of W. Catalpa Avenue will need to access the alley via W. Bryn Mawr Avenue.
- There will be noise while work is being performed:
  - General construction noise
  - Loud noise from viaduct demolition
  - Running air compressors, excavators, and generators
  - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
  - Beeping for backup alarms on vehicles
  - Flagger horns
