We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Friday, February 4 to Monday, February 7, 2022

Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments.

Location: W. Bryn Mawr Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 8pm-Friday to 5am-Monday (Continuous around the clock work)

Work Activity: Drilled Shaft Installation

Local Impact:

- W. Bryn Mawr Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- The sidewalk on the north side of the street will be closed
- The sidewalk on the south side of the street will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary.
- Access to businesses on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained.
- Access to the Bryn Mawr station entrance on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, **including nighttime noise:**
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
