

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Date(s): Monday, May 9 to Friday, September 30, 2022

Dates are subject to change due to weather and construction schedule adjustments.

Location: Underneath the CTA elevated tracks west of:

1032 - 1040 W. Montrose Avenue

4400 - 4458 N. Broadway

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm weekdays; potential weekend work

Work Activity: Lead Abatement & Painting

Local Impact:

- Crews will work south to north.
- The parking lot located underneath the CTA tracks just north of W. Montrose Avenue will not be accessible for the duration of this work.
- Access to the parking garage at 1032 1040 W. Montrose Avenue will be maintained.
- Crews will abate and paint the CTA structure, using the following tools, some of which will produce noise:
 - Containment covers
 - Portable generator and air compressor
 - Blast Equipment & Power tools
 - A specialized vacuum
 - Environmental monitoring equipment
- Crews will collect paint chips, debris and dust and dispose pursuant to Illinois EPA Guidelines for Hazardous Waste.
