Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. UPDATED DATES EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Dates: Weekdays & Saturdays
Friday, July 1 to Tuesday, July 12, 2022

Location: W. Catalpa Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 7am-7pm, **continuous 24/7 street closure**

Work Activity: Track Support Structure Installation & Staging

Local Impact:

- W. Catalpa Avenue between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone, underneath the CTA tracks will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Catalpa Avenue.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times with flagger assistance when necessary.
- Residents north of W. Catalpa Avenue will need to access the alley via W. Bryn Mawr Avenue.
- Residents south of W. Catalpa Avenue will need to access the alley via W. Balmoral Avenue.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from track structure segment deliveries, crane lifts, and other construction activities
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
