Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. DAILY LANE SHIFTS & SIDEWALK CLOSURES

Dates: Monday, June 17 to Friday, June 21, 2024

Location: W. Winona Street just west of the CTA Tracks

Work Hours: 7am-5pm

Work Activity: Utility Relocation

Local Impact:

- There will be lane shifts on W. Winona Street, just west of the CTA Tracks.
- The alley entrance on the north side of W. Winona Street on the west side of the CTA Tracks will be closed during stated work hours.
- Access to the alley will be available at the end of each work day.
- There will be No Parking on both sides of W. Winona Street within the work zone just west of the CTA Tracks until the work activity is complete.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Winona Street.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- Access to the Argyle station entrance on W. Winona Street will be maintained at all times.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from saw cutting pavement
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
