

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

DAILY STREET CLOSURES

Dates: Tuesday, October 3 to Saturday, October 7, 2023

Location: W. Winona Street between N. Broadway and N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 7am-7pm

Work Activity: Embankment Wall Demolition & Removal & Street Repairs

Local Impact:

- Crews will be demolishing the embankment wall north and south of W. Winona Street and repairing the street, requiring daily closures of W. Winona Street between N. Broadway and N. Winthrop Avenue.
- ***The Argyle Station entrance on W. Winona Street will remain accessible at all times from N. Broadway and from N. Winthrop Avenue.***
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Winona Street.
- One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary.
- Residents south of W. Winona Street will need to access the alley via W. Argyle Street.
- Residents north of W. Winona Street will need to access the alley via W. Foster Avenue.
- ***Access to doors 5 and 6 at Goudy School will be maintained.***
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from viaduct demolition
 - Running air compressors, excavators and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
