Work Activity: Local Impact:

Duct Bank Installation

- Ardmore Avenue between Broadway Avenue to Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic.
- The sidewalk on the south side of Ardmore Avenue will be closed.
- The sidewalk on the north side of Ardmore Avenue will remain open.
- The alley will be local traffic only to access parking lots via Ardmore Avenue from Broadway Avenue.
- Parking lanes on the east side of Broadway Avenue between Ardmore Avenue to Bryn Mawr Avenue will be closed during the weekends.
- Parking lanes on the north and south sides of Ardmore Avenue between Broadway Avenue to Winthrop Avenue will remain closed during weekdays for the duration of this
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Use of pneumatic tools and generators
 - Noise from rail equipment, heavy machinery and maintenance equipment
 - o Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
