## UPDATED DATES

### ALLEY ENTRANCE RELOCATION & DAILY SHORT-TERM STREET CLOSURES

**Dates:** Saturday, November 9 to Saturday, December 7, 2024

**Location:** - The alley east of 5001 - 5077 N. Broadway & 1135 W. Winona Street  
(W. Argyle Street to W. Winona Street)  
- W. Winona Street at the CTA Tracks

**Work Hours:** 7am to 7pm

**Work Activity:** Crane Staging & Material Delivery

**Local Impact:**

- The alley entrance on the south side of W. Winona Street on the west side of the CTA Tracks will be temporarily relocated east to the CTA right-of-way to provide continued access to the alley at all times.
- During concrete placement, a short-term daily closure of W. Winona Street will take place between 7am and 5pm at the CTA Tracks with local traffic maintained outside the work zone.
- There will be No Parking on both sides of W. Winona Street between N. Broadway and the CTA Tracks
- Approximately seven (7) short-term daily street closures are anticipated during the listed date range.
- The sidewalk on the south side of the street within the work zone will be closed at all times.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Winona Street will remain open at all times.
- Access to the Argyle station entrance on W. Winona Street will be maintained at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
  - Flagger horns
