We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

## EXTENDED ALLEY CLOSURE

### Weekdays & Saturdays

**Dates:** **Wednesday, September 25 to Saturday, October 12, 2024**

**Location:** The alley behind 5300 – 5358 N. Winthrop Avenue  
(W. Berwyn Avenue to W. Balmoral Avenue)

**Work Hours:** **7am-7pm, continuous 24/7 alley closure**

**Work Activity:** Alley Reconstruction

**Local Impact:**

- The alley will be closed at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between W. Berwyn Avenue and W. Balmoral Avenue on the east side of the CTA Tracks during this closure.
- ***For your safety, please do not attempt to use the alley for any purpose unless in an emergency situation.***

- Garbage and recycling bins will be relocated to N. Winthrop Avenue by the contractor until the work activity is complete. Please dispose of garbage and recycling in your relocated bins located on N. Winthrop Avenue until the alley is reopened and the contractor has moved bins back.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Loud noise from pavement demolition
  - Beeping from backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
