

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED PARTIAL-ALLEY CLOSURE

Weekdays & Saturdays

Dates: Thursday, December 5 to Monday, December 23, 2024

Location: The alley west of 4930 – 4940 N. Winthrop Avenue & 1107 – 1115 W. Argyle Street (W. Ainslie Street to W. Argyle Street)

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm; continuous 24/7 partial-alley closure

Work Activity: Alley Reconstruction

Local Impact:

- The alley west of 4930 – 4940 N. Winthrop Avenue & 1107 – 1115 W. Argyle Street will be closed at all times.
- ***For your safety, please do not attempt to use the closed portion of the alley for any purpose unless in an emergency situation.***
- Access to the alley and garages/parking spaces west of 4900 – 4928 N. Winthrop Avenue will be maintained via W. Ainslie Avenue at all times
- Access to the east/west alley between 4940 N. Winthrop Avenue & 1107 – 1115 W. Argyle Street will remain accessible via N. Winthrop Avenue only.
- No private, dedicated parking spaces will be impacted with this closure.
- Garbage and recycling bins in the closed portion of the alley will be relocated by the contractor until the work activity completes. Please dispose of garbage and recycling in your relocated bins until the alley is reopened and the contractor has moved bins back.
 - Bins for 1109-1115 W. Argyle Street will be relocated to the east/west alley south of 1107-1115 W. Argyle Street.
 - Bins for 4930 – 4940 N. Winthrop Avenue will be relocated to N. Winthrop Avenue.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - **Loud noise from pavement demolition**
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
