We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Dates: Weekdays & Saturdays
Thursday, December 5, 2024 to Saturday, January 18, 2025

Location: W. Argyle Street at the CTA Tracks

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm; continuous (24/7) street closure

Work Activity: Argyle Station Utility Connections & Platform Steel Installation

Local Impact:

- W. Argyle Street at the CTA Tracks will be closed to vehicular traffic until the work activity is complete.
- Local access will be maintained on W. Argyle Street east and west of the CTA Tracks outside the work zone.
- The parking lanes on both sides of W. Argyle Street between N. Broadway and the CTA Tracks will be closed until the work activity is complete.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Argyle Street.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- Access to businesses on W. Argyle Street will be maintained at all times.
- Access to the alley on the south side of W. Argyle Street on the east side of the CTA Tracks will be maintained via N. Winthrop Avenue & W. Ainslie Street (*any direct alley impacts will be communicated via separate Construction Activity Notice*).
- Access to the alley on the north side of W. Argyle Street on the east side of the CTA Tracks will be maintained via W. Winona Street.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicle
