

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED LANE SHIFT & SIDEWALK CLOSURE

- Dates:** Weekdays & Saturday
Thursday, April 24 to Friday, May 30, 2025
- Location:** W. Ainslie Street between N. Broadway and N. Winthrop Avenue
- Work Hours:** 7am-7pm; continuous lane shift & sidewalk closure
- Work Activity:** Street & Sidewalk Reconstruction
- Local Impact:**
- Work will take place on the north half of the street first and once completed, the work zone will relocate to the south side of the street.
 - There will be a lane shift around the work zone until the work activity is completed.
 - There will be NO PARKING on both sides of W. Ainslie Street between N. Broadway and N. Winthrop Avenue.
 - **Access to South-East Asia Center School's drop-off and pick-up location will be maintained via the entrance closest to N. Broadway until work completes on the north side of the street.**
 - Access to the parking garage entrance for 4848 N. Winthrop Avenue on W. Ainslie Street will be maintained at all times.
 - Access to the garage at 1112 W. Ainslie Street will be restricted until work completes on the north side of the street.
 - Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Ainslie Street.
 - One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary.
 - Access to alleys adjacent to the CTA Tracks will be maintained via W. Argyle Street and W. Lawrence Avenue. Any alley impacts will be communicated via separate Construction Activity Notice.
 - There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from pavement and sidewalk demolition
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction vehicles and equipment
