Work Hours: Continuous daytime and nighttime work

Work Activity: Retaining Wall Demolition and Restoration

- The alley behind N. Winthrop Avenue will be partially closed.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley behind 5818-5828 N. Winthrop Avenue from **June 17 – June 28, 2020**.

- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Use of handheld jackhammers

 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
