

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Wednesday, June 3 to Wednesday, July 1, 2020

Location: W. Montrose Avenue between N. Clifton Avenue and N. Kenmore Avenue

Work Hours: Continuous Daytime and Nighttime Work

Work Activity: Interlocking Installation

Local Impact: June 3 – July 1

- The parking lanes on both sides of W. Montrose Avenue within the work zone will be closed.

June 13 – June 27

- W. Montrose Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic.
- The sidewalks on W. Montrose Avenue will be closed on one side at a time.
- Delivery and local traffic access to N. Sunnyside Avenue will be maintained.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Use of rivet removal equipment (handheld jackhammers) to remove old structural rivets
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Metal on metal material handling
 - Noise from rail equipment, crane and maintenance equipment
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagger horns
