

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Friday, August 14 to Wednesday, August 26, 2020

Location:

- The alley west of 4208-4364 N. Kenmore Avenue
- W. Montrose Avenue between N. Clifton Avenue and N. Kenmore Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm, weekdays

Work Activity: Micropile Drilling and Installation

Local Impact:

- Access to the alley behind N. Kenmore Avenue from W. Montrose Avenue will be prohibited (24/7) until the work activity is completed.
- The alley will be accessible for local traffic only from W. Buena Avenue.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Montrose Avenue will be closed under the CTA tracks.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. Montrose Avenue will remain open.
- The parking lanes on W. Montrose Avenue will be closed between N. Clifton Avenue and N. Kenmore Avenue.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from excavation, drilling, and loading
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
